Conditions of Entry

1. Instructions on how to enter form part of these Conditions of Entry. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these conditions.

3. The Promotion commences on 1st April 2010 and closes on 31st May 2010.
4. Entry is only open to schools that have registered for the 2010 McDonald's Hooptime Program.

The registered McDonald's Hooptime Schools judged the winners of the Competition will win one of five McDonald's Hooptime \$1000 Equipment Grants. Total value of all prizes for the Promotion is \$5,000. The \$1,000 will not be given as cash, rather, equipment will be supplied directly to the school or direct payment of service in the case that the school has not requested equipment.
